My husband, Jeff, and I have been steady donors to TheHopeLine for over 25 years. However, my first connection with Dawson McAllister occurred 10 years prior, when he came and gave a message about the value of fathers at First Baptist Church in Sioux Falls.

It was such a powerful address, and I cried through most of it! I had longed for the kind

of connection with my dad that Dawson spoke of. I remember Dawson challenging the fathers at the church to come forward if they were willing to make a new commitment — to step up and be the dads that their kids needed ... and they did! It left such an impression on me

and drew me to learn more about Dawson's unique ministry.

Fast forward to 2007, when our youngest daughter was a junior at Sioux Falls Christian School. Dawson was scheduled to speak at the school's chapel service during a time that our daughter was struggling with some difficulties in her life — it was a divine intervention.

During his visit, Dawson met with our

daughter and invited her to come and tour the local radio station where his program was airing. She had the opportunity to be interviewed by him during a live broadcast. To this day, our daughter remembers the kindness and love Dawson showed her and the help and guidance he provided.

God led me to volunteer at Direct Line

Prayer Center in Sioux
Falls in 2008, the
same year Direct Line
began partnering with
TheHopeLine. As Hope
Coaches gathered
prayer requests from
young people, we had
the privilege to pray over
them. When they were
in town, Dawson and his
team always enjoyed

coming into our center themselves for prayer. He would say, "There's just something special about Direct Line." We are so grateful for the partnership we have shared all these years, as prayer is the foundation for both ministries.

Jeff and I have been especially drawn toward TheHopeLine because it gives words of life to the wounded. Young people who are lying on "the battlefield of life," bleeding

Every gift dated and postmarked by December 31, 2025, can apply to this year's taxes and have eternal ministry benefits, too. Great options for year-end giving include:

- IRA Rollover. If you're 70½ years of age or older, you can make a qualified charitable donation (QCD) of up to \$108,000 directly from your traditional IRA without adding a penny to your taxable income. For most people aged 73 or older, this also counts toward your required minimum distribution (check with your financial advisor to confirm).
- Appreciated Assets. Receive a charitable income tax deduction if you have owned the asset (stocks; bonds; real estate such as homes, vacation properties, commercial or undeveloped land) more than 12 months. You will also likely avoid the capital gains tax on the appreciation that you would have owed if you had sold the asset. Therefore, more resources will go toward ministering the hope and love of God to young people in need.
- **Donor Advised Fund.** Now is a great time to distribute grants from your DAF to TheHopeLine. These funds are already set aside for ministry and your select charities, so you can give freely, impacting lives 24/7 through TheHopeLine, without touching your ready capital.
