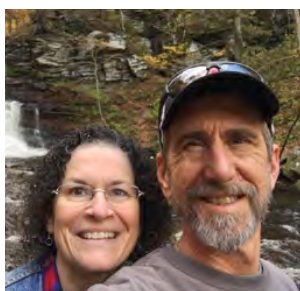

Here are a few reflections from one Hope Coach named “Olive”:

“I grew up in a non-religious home, and when I first heard about Jesus as a young teen, I immediately knew something had been missing in my life. Even though I loved Jesus, I still struggled deeply with fear, depression, anxiety, and suicidal thoughts because I didn’t really know what walking with Him looked like yet.”

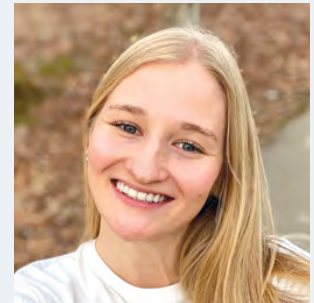
“In one of my darkest seasons, I felt God calling me to missions. I ended up doing a discipleship training school in Hawaii, and it completely changed my life. I’ve been serving in missions ever since, and I love Jesus more every day.”

“What stirred my heart to become a Hope Coach was watching my own brother struggle with suicidal thoughts. One night, I saw him wanting to take his life, and I had no idea what to do. When I learned about TheHopeLine, I felt like God was giving me the opportunity to be trained to help young people in similar situations.”

“What surprises me most is how much God can do through even a 45-minute chat. Someone can come in feeling completely suicidal and leave with real hope after hearing about Jesus.”

“Many young people today are terrified of disappointing their parents, even if they never say it out loud. Listening without immediately reacting builds more trust than many parents realize.”
